- Liaising with client's and MSF personnel on site
- Carrying out a Risk Assessment prior to the commencement of any work activity
- Ensure all installations are completed to the correct standard, delivered on time and to budget.
- Completing relevant documentation, paperwork and raising on-site issue's
- Maintain a high level of health and safety as per company policies/procedures
 - Ensure all works are completed as per MSF QEHS policies and procedures
 - Report and QEHS issues to supervisor and via Eyes and Ears App

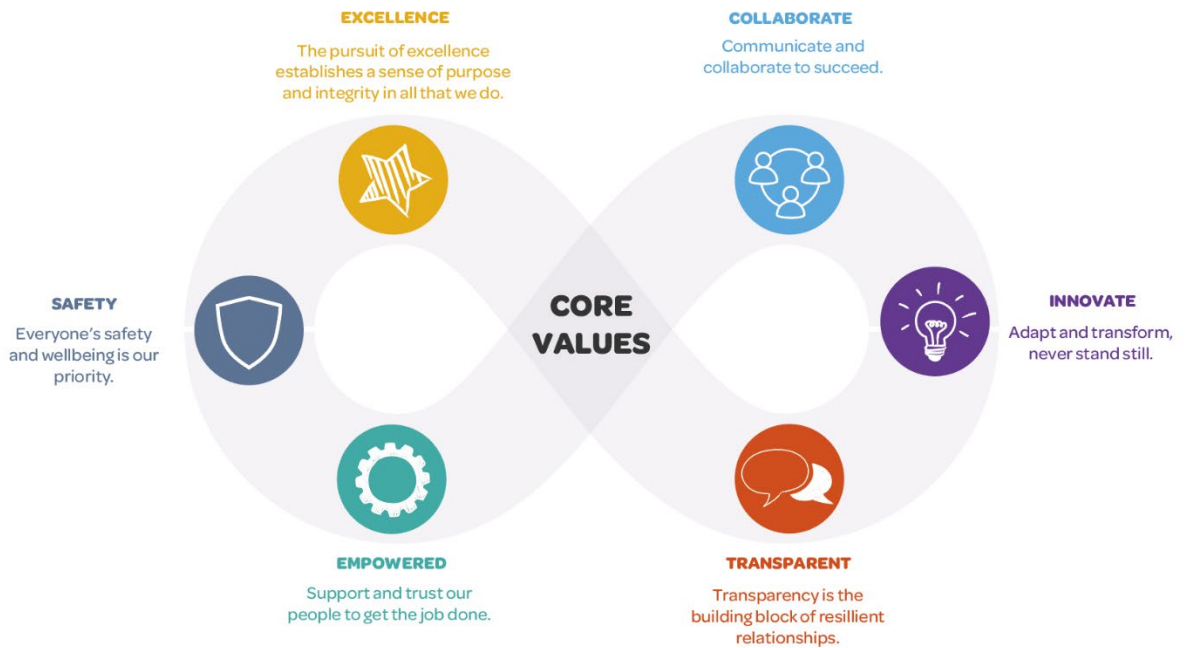
